

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING OF APRIL 13, 2009
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor pro tem Korbelic. Mayor Walter and Councilman Tussy were absent.

Approval of Minutes: Council reviewed the minutes from the March 9 Council Meeting. Councilman Davis motioned to approve the minutes with a second motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Expenses: Council reviewed the financial report. Councilman Roberts motioned to approve the finance report with a second motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Citizen Comments: Mr. Gardner complained about trash from housing construction across the street blew onto his property. He spoke to staff the previous week and staff had contacted the builder to clean it up. It appeared they didn't so Councilman Roberts said he would also talk to the builder. Major Ruckel noted that the Sheriff can be called in such an event of "littering". Mrs. Box also noted that the trash service has refuse that blows onto property while dumping into the truck.

Discussion/Review of Sheriff Programs and Activities with Major Ruckel: Major Ruckel reviewed last month's activity and discussed home false alarms, registration, citizen's patrol program and the citizen's academy that will hold class in September.

Discussion/Action on Road Repairs in the Town (ie. West Shore and Drain Drive): Council reviewed the quotes for to repair the damage on West Shore Dr/ remove what appear to be speed bumps on Drain Dr. Gentry's Asphalt will do the work.

Discussion/Action on Choosing New Street Signs: Council reviewed the proposed street sign layout and made suggestions to improve it. Also, the speed sign on Lavon Pkwy near Parker Rd. will be tightened or repaired.

Discussion/Action on Ordinance 191 – Adopt New Flood Insurance Program: This ordinance adopts the Flood Insurance program that is recommended by the State. Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve the ordinance with a second motion made by Councilman Davis. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor's comments:

Code Enforcement Status: Council reviewed the enforcement reports and discussed the current activity.

May 9th Election: Early voting will be held April 27 to May 1, 9am – 1pm, May 4 and 5, 7am -7pm and Election Day 7am – 7pm, all at Town Hall.

April 25th Clean up Day: Still on schedule for April 25, 2009. The schedule of volunteers will be e-mailed. Refreshments will be available.

Adjournment: Councilman Roberts motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8.25 p.m. with a second motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.
