

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING OF FEBRUARY 8, 2010  
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Walter. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes:

Council reviewed the minutes from the January 11 Council Meeting. Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve the minutes with a second motion made by Councilman McCasland. The motion passed unanimously.

Council reviewed the minutes from the January 25 Board of Adjustments Meeting. Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve the minutes with a second motion made by Councilman Tussy. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Expenses: Council reviewed the expenses report. Councilman Tussy motioned to approve the minutes with a second motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Citizen's Comments: Mr. Falzone protested the recent Allied Waste price increase claiming it was done without notice to the residents and that the competitor costs less. He also complained about belligerent speeders on Vista Oaks Drive. Mayor Walter was empathetic but explained that the rate increase was authorized in the contract and discussed in open meetings that were properly posted. He also explained that the Sheriff needed to be called on all speeders.

Mrs. Rhine spoke in favor of the waste service and explained she was at both the earlier vendor selection and rate increase meetings that were open to all.

Mr. Kellow complained about the number of dogs in her area. Staff has notified animal control and they have a plan of action to remedy the problem.

Discussion/Action on Resolution 10-02-08 – Call for General Election – May 8, 2010: Council discussed the election order. Mayor Walter and Councilmember Korbelic and Tussy are up for re-election. Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve the resolution with a second motion made by Mayor pro tem Korbelic. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action on Signs Lease Agreement with Collin Park Marina: The Mayor explained that this was a renewal of the existing contract and asked Mr. Castro of the Marina if he would allow St. Paul residents, with proof of residence, free entry to the park. Mr. Castro agreed if the residents are tolerant in case of any errors. Mayor pro tem Korbelic motioned to approve the agreement with a second motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor's comments:

Code Enforcement Status: – Council reviewed and discussed the enforcement reports

Clean up Day: Council agreed to another Spring clean up at Town Hall to be scheduled on April 10, 17 or 24.

Adjournment: Councilman Scanlan motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8.06 p.m. with a second motion made by Mayor pro tem Korbelic. The motion passed unanimously.
