

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING OF MARCH 8, 2010
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by Mayor Walter. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes:
