

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING OF FEBRUARY 14, 2011
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Walter. Councilman Scanlan was absent. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Introduction/General Discussion with New Collin County Commissioner: Mayor Walter welcomed and introduced Commissioner Williams. She answered Council questions and talked about County activities.

The Park Boulevard issue was discussed as to how it should not have been accepted by the Town. Her staff is looking into the issue and determining the cost of accepting it. Redistricting efforts, the Austin Collin County days in March, outside committee membership, the County Thoroughfare plan, TxDot and the Parker Road extension was discussed.

Approval of Minutes:

Council reviewed the minutes from the January 10 Council meeting. Councilman Gensler motioned to approve the minutes with a second to the motion made by Councilman Kellow. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Expenses: Councilman Gensler motioned to approve the monthly expenses report with a second to the motion made by Councilman McCasland. The motion passed unanimously.

Citizen's Comments: A representative from Community Waste Disposal requested that they be allowed to bid on the next Waste Services contract. The current contract term is up for renewal in January 2012.

Discussion/Action on Resolution 11-02-14 – Call for General Election – May 14, 2011: Council reviewed the Order for three councilmember two year terms and one councilman to (re)fill the second year of ex-councilman Korbelic's seat. Councilman Kellow motioned to accept the resolution with a second to the motion made by Councilman McCasland. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action on Weed Control for 2011: Council reviewed the proposal to kill vegetation Alongside the asphalt roads. Councilman Kellow motioned to accept the resolution with a second to the motion made by Councilman McCasland. The motion passed unanimously.

Code Enforcement Status - Council reviewed the enforcement activity and reports. The Harris complaint was discussed. We are sending Bruce Hopewell out to take a look at it and she will be provided status.
