

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING OF MARCH 12, 2012  
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Walter. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes:

Council reviewed the minutes from the February 13, 2012 Council meeting. Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve the minutes with a second to the motion made by Councilman Kellow. The motion passed unanimously. Council reviewed the minutes from the February 20, 2012 Board of Adjustments meeting. Councilman Kellow motioned to approve the minutes with a second to the motion made by Mayor pro tem McCasland. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Expenses: Council reviewed the expenses report. Councilman Gensler motioned to approve the monthly expenses report with a second to the motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Citizen's Comments: Gene Sera addressed Council on his candidacy to County Court at Law #2.

Discussion/Action on Approving Ordinance 199 - Contract with Allied Waste: Council discussed the cleanup day scheduling and payment, and changing the placement/removal of containers from 12 hours to 24. Councilman Gensler motioned to accept the resolution with changes with a second to the motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action on Resolution 12-03-13 – Cancel General Election for May 12, 2012:

Council reviewed the resolution. Councilman Gensler motioned to accept the resolution with a second to the motion made by Councilman Scanlan. Councilman Simmons abstained. The motion passed.

Discussion/Action on Paving Collin County Mutual Boundary Roads (Aztec Trail): Secretary Dunn reviewed the Aztec paving costs and income from residents on that road and requested that Council agrees to let the County pave it. Councilman Scanlan requested to table the item until updated cost is available with a second to the motion made by Mayor pro tem McCasland. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action on Ordinance #200 – Franchise Agreement/Contract with Farmers Electric Corporation: Council reviewed the progress on and intent of the agreement. Mayor pro tem McCasland motioned to accept the Ordinance with changes to the disputed sections as accepted by the Town attorney with a second to the motion made by Councilman Kellow. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor's comments:

Code Enforcement/Status - Council reviewed the enforcement activity and reports.
