

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING OF NOVEMBER 12, 2012  
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Walter. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes: Council reviewed the minutes from the October 8, 2012 Board of Adjustment meeting. Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve the minutes with a second to the motion made by Councilman Gensler. The motion passed unanimously.

Council reviewed the minutes from the October 8, 2012 Council meeting. Councilman Simmons motioned to approve the minutes with a second to the motion made by Councilman Kellow. The motion passed unanimously.

Approval of Expenses: Council reviewed the expense report. Councilman Gensler motioned to approve the monthly expense report with a second to the motion made by Councilman Scanlan. The motion passed unanimously.

Citizen's Comments: Mr. Egbers requested clarification on the topics for planned P&Z meetings. There will be a meeting on Ordinance 130 edits, then one on zoning Case 2012-1. There has been no formal request for apartments on FM1378.

Discussion/Action on Resolution 11-12-12 – Accepting the 2011-2012 Tax Rolls: After Council reviewed the resolution, Councilman Scanlan motioned to approve it with a second to the motion made by Councilman Kellow. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion/Action on Ordinance 202 - Establish Regulations Governing the Sale and Service of Alcoholic Beverages within the Town of St. Paul: Council reviewed the resolution and requested information on other City's liquor admin fees. Councilman Simmons motioned to table the item with a second to the motion made by Councilman Gensler. The motion passed unanimously.
