

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING HELD MONDAY, OCT 14, 2013
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Walter. All members were present. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

October 14, 2013 Council minutes: Minutes from Sept. 9, 2013 were amended to include statement made by Mr. Bruni that discussions have taken place with WISD regarding locating a school in the development. Motion to approve 10/14/13 minutes made by Mr. Scanlan, second by Mr. Gensler. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF EXPENSES: Motion to approve expenses made by Mr. Scanlan, second by Mr. Kellow. Motion passed unanimously.

RECOGNITION OF BRUCE DUNN'S SERVICE TO ST. PAUL: Bruce and Sherry Dunn were in attendance. Mayor Walter presented a plaque to Mr. Dunn in appreciation for his dedication and the improvements and organization he brought to the town. "I think I left it in better shape than I found it", Bruce stated. Everyone agreed wholeheartedly.

CITIZENS COMMENTS: Mr. Dunn asked about the reopening of the BBQ restaurant at FM 1378 x Parker Rd. The Town related that they have passed building and health inspections and that a CO has been issued.
