

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING HELD MONDAY, JUNE 9, 2014  
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Walter. Mr. Kellow, Mr. McCasland, and Mr. Scanlan, and Mr. Walter were present. Mr. Simmons and Mr. Gensler were absent. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ELECTION RESULTS:** Mayor – Opie Walter, Seat 3 – Robert Kellow, Seat 5 – Robert Simmons. Mayor Walter was sworn in by Secretary London. Alderman Kellow was sworn in by Mayor Walter. Mr. Kellow made a motion to have Mr. Simmons serve as Mayor Pro-Tem for the next year, seconded by Mr. Scanlan. Motion carried and was unanimous.

**P&Z REPORT ON FINAL PLAT APPLICATIONS FOR INSPIRATION PHASES 1A-1, 1A-2, AND 1B:** P&Z chairman, Cam Davis, presented report to council on May 28, 2014 P&Z Public Hearing. The P&Z Commission voted unanimously to recommend that the St. Paul Town Council approve the Final Plat applications for Inspiration Phases 1A-1, 1A-2, and 1B.
