

**MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING HELD MONDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2014  
AT ST. PAUL TOWN HALL**

The Meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. by Mayor Walter. Mr. Simmons, Mr. McCasland, and Mr. Kellow, and Mayor Walter were present. Mr. Gensler was absent. There was a quorum. Mayor Walter called for a moment of silence to commemorate John Scanlan and his service to the Town of St. Paul. Mayor Walter led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Motion to approve minutes of October 13, 2014 Council Meeting made by Mr. Kellow, seconded by Mr. McCasland. Motion passed unanimously. Motion to approve minutes of October 27, 2014 Special Council Meeting made by Mr. Simmons, seconded by Mr. Kellow. Motion passed unanimously. Motion to approve minutes of October 27, 2014 Council Workshop made by Mr. Simmons, seconded by Mr. Kellow. Motion passed unanimously.

**APPROVAL OF EXPENSES:** Council reviewed the previous month's expenses. Motion to approve expenses made by Mr. Simmons and seconded by Mr. Kellow. Motion passed unanimously.

**CITIZENS COMMENTS:** Ellis Merworth (Lakeview Dr.) had a question about Inspiration sign discussion from previous meeting. There were no other citizen comments.

**AMAZING GRACE FELLOWSHIP CHURCH FIRE:** Representatives of AGF are in negotiations to sell 3 of their 4 acres to The Lakes Church of Wylie. They requested the town delay condemning the sanctuary building for 60 days (January 10, 2014). The town will grant 60 day delay to allow the entities to finalize terms of sale. The idea is to repair and save the slab and build a new sanctuary on it.

**RESOLUTION 14-11-10:** A resolution recommending WISD name the new Inspiration elementary school be named John and Paula Scanlan Elementary School. Motion to approve resolution made by Mr. Kellow, seconded by Mr. McCasland. Motion passed unanimously.

**ORDINANCE 206:** An ordinance banning fireworks sales in the St. Paul ETJ. Motion to approve made by Mr. Kellow, there was no second. Motion did not pass.
