Collin Park Season Passes

St. Paul residents are eligible to get one free Collin Park season pass per household with proof of residency. Last year's passes expired 2-29-16. It allows one vehicle w/ 4 passengers and 1 watercraft trailer to enter the park. Go to the Collin Park gate office to get your pass.

Spring Clean Up & Green Up Day

The Town is having a Spring Clean-Up Day. It will held be on Saturday, Apr. 23 from 8 to 2. In addition to bulk trash dumpsters, the town will be accepting electronics, paint, chemicals, batteries, and 4 tires per household. As usual, members of your Town Council and Town Staff will be on hand to assist you.

May 2016 Election

The May 7th election for council seats has been cancelled. All candidates were unopposed. This allows the town to forgo the expense of an election. The following persons will be declared elected in June. Seat 3 – Robert Kellow. Seat 5 – Robert Simmons. Mayor – Opie Walter.

Outdoor Burning

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has generally prohibited all outdoor burning with a few exceptions which can be found in the TCEQ website. If your situation fits all the requirements for one of the exceptions found in the TCEQ OUTDOOR BURNING RULES, you may conduct outdoor burning as long as you comply with all TCEQ conditions and you call Wylie Fire Rescue and alert them ahead of time.

Mowing Reminder

We have reached the mowing season early this year. It is the responsibility of each property owner to keep their lawns mowed. This includes mowing and edging out to the edge of the road that abuts their property, even if it is a city, county, or TxDot right-of-way. Thanks in advance for all your efforts in keeping the tall grass in check. It makes the whole town look better.

St. Paul has acquired the services of several new professionals to help with public health and safety.

Steve Berry is the town's new **Health Inspector**. He is a private Registered Environmental Health Specialist -Registered Sanitarian- Health Inspector. He will be inspecting and advising all food establishments in town.

Travis Caperton is the town's new **Code Enforcement Officer**. He is a Texas DSHS Registered Code Enforcement Officer and is also a Sr. Code Enforcement Officer for the City of Carrollton.

Dale Maberry is with the **Collin County Fire Marshal's Office**. He will be doing fire code inspections on all commercial and public establishments.
